**Rev. Thomas L. Bowen** is the Earl L. Harrison Minister of Social Justice at the historic Shiloh Baptist Church of Washington, DC and has faithfully served that congregation as a member of the ministerial team in various capacities since July 2002.

Rev. Bowen is also the Director of African American Strategic Engagement in the Executive Office of DC Mayor Muriel Bowser where he serves as both the Director of the Mayor's Office on African American Affairs and the Mayor's Office of Religious Affairs. He is considered the chief advocate and voice of both the African American community and the faith community in the District of Columbia. He is often called "DC's Pastor."

Rev. Bowen is a graduate of Morehouse College, where he was a Ford Foundation Scholar, and received his ministerial and theological training from The Divinity School at the University of Chicago.
