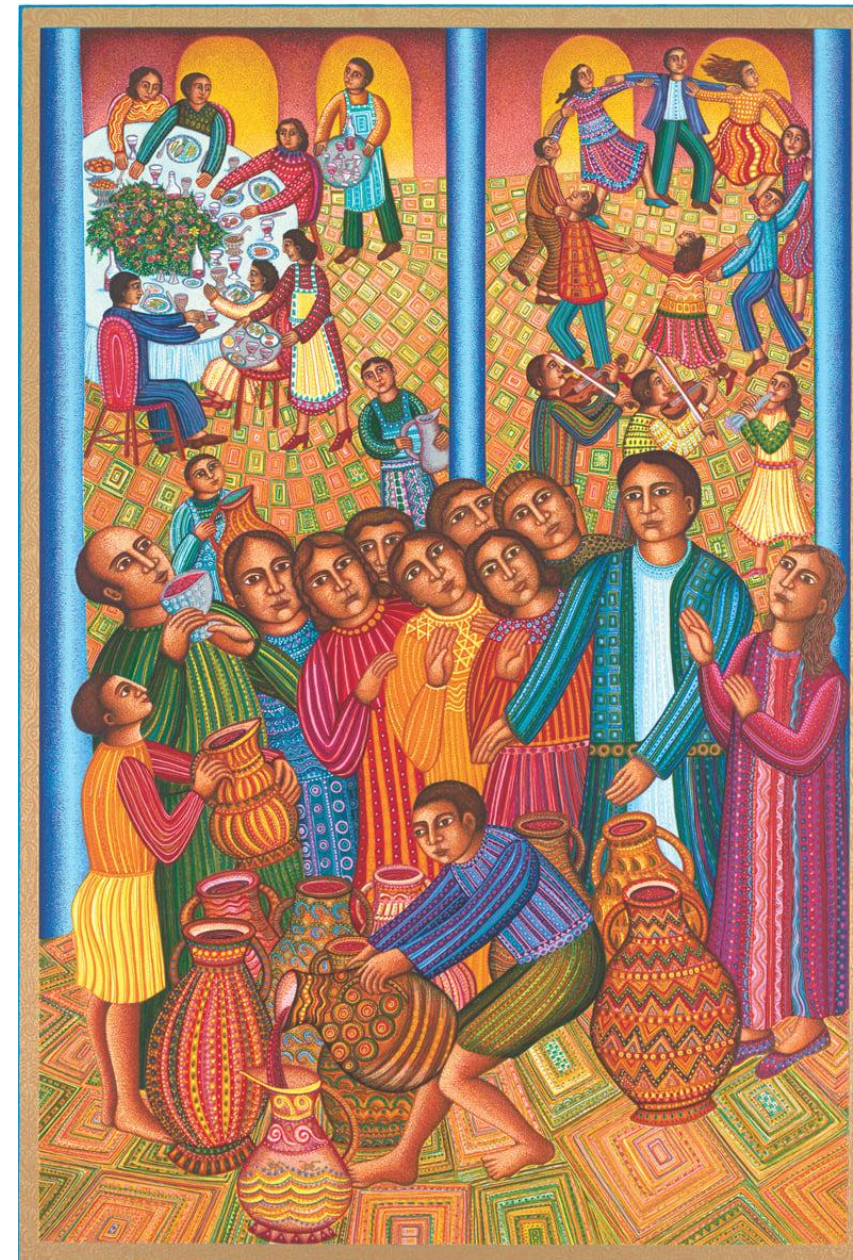

***Lessons from the Gospels, John 2:1-12** Cathy Baskin & Leah Davis
